It's happening! We can OFFICIALLY CONFIRM that we are reopening our doors Monday, May 11th at 9am. While our day to day will still look quite different, as we have limited resources and are still not allowing clients into the building for the time being, we are all chomping at the bit to get back to serving our community.

Our staff are taking every precaution to limit any possible spread of COVID. We have received large donations of masks and personal-size hand sanitizer, and we are washing our hands and sanitizing surfaces as much as we can. In addition, all of our services are being offered "to-go"; clients will check in at the door for food and hygiene items to limit any exposure to or from staff members, volunteers and other clients.

During this time, we are also resuming our ASK OF THE MONTH! For the month of May we are asking for NONPERISHABLE FOOD ITEMS (think pantry stocking stuff, like canned goods, box meals, noodles, rice, etc). We are also accepting hygiene products and monetary donations but ask for you to hold on to your clothing donations at this time due to limited space (and the inability to provide clothing to our clients at this time).

We are also accepting volunteers! However, as we are not resuming counseling services just yet, our volunteer options are looking a little different (but just as necessary!!).
